

The Cage at break and lunchtime



The Cage is an important break and lunch time location for all of our students who enjoy playing football. Let's all follow these rules so that everyone can enjoy playing football, be kind to each other and stay safe every break and lunch time:

- 1) You are only allowed in the cage if you plan to play football. Do not enter the cage to stand around and chat. Do not 'drop your bag' by the fence if you are not staying in the cage.
- 2) All students entering the cage should place their bags by the fence and either a) have a football or b) identify whose football they are playing with that duty.
- 3) No students are allowed to eat in the cage (as this is a health and safety risk).
- 4) Any student who 'boots' a ball in the air/ out of the cage will be told to leave the cage immediately (as this is dangerous behaviour).
- 5) If a student 'boots' a football of a student in another year group/ a student who they are not playing a match with they will be issued a detention as this is a form of bullying.
- 6) All students must leave the cage as soon as the whistle is blown at 10:12am (break) or 1:02pm (lunch) so that staff can get the cage ready for line up.


