

Students with 95% attendance and above, achieved nearly two GCSE grades higher than a student with 85-90% attendance

Punctuality impacts on learning

- Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year
- Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year
- Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year
- If you arrive late to school or late to lesson, you will be given a centralised detention for one hour that same day.
